## ADA Self Evaluation

Last Updated on October 10, 2016

1. Notice of auxiliary aids listed on all meeting agendas for all boards and commissions was started in April 2014.
2. Town offices were upgraded with ADA compliant entry automatic doors in 2007.
3. ADA compliant sidewalks with curb ramps have been installed at our three Tot Parks.
4. All new subdivisions are required to install ADA compliant sidewalk ramps in all new subdivisions (this has been in effect since 2005).

Winfield was incorporated in 1993 and is a rapidly growing bedroom community with a small downtown that has developed over the past 20 years. Established residential subdivisions that started in the early 1990's did not have sidewalks and were lots on at least 1 acre. In the early 2000's residential developments became denser and now include sidewalks. Our two subdivisions, Country Meadow Estates and Doubletree West have sidewalks but not fully compliant ADA sidewalk curb ramps are on the schedule to be replaced with ADA compliant ramps over the next 3-5 years with available CDBG funding.

Winfield adopted a Downtown Master Plan the summer of 2016 which prioritizes the installation of ADA compliant sidewalks in the downtown district (there are currently no sidewalks of any kind). Funding from the Winfield 109<sup>th</sup> and Randolph TIF district will be utilized to start installation of ADA compliant sidewalks along with the assistance of business owners in the district to make our downtown more accessible to all of our residents. All new businesses constructing new buildings are now required to install ADA compliant sidewalks on their property.

The Town of Winfield does not own any public buildings; the town offices are owned by the Winfield Township and are managed and operated by the Winfield Township Trustee. The only physical building the Town owns is the street department office and maintenance facility. Any improvements to this building will be reviewed to determine additional ADA improvements that should be incorporated in the modifications.

The Town currently own and maintains three small "tot" parks, each with playground equipment. The newest park in Stonegate Commons has the improved pour-in-place surface which is ADA compliant. The older "tot" parks have recycled rubber mulch and hardwood mulch which are also ADA compliant but not as easily accessible as the pour-in-place is. Any future improvements to equipment at any town park should include the use of pour-in-place surfacing and equipment that is ADA accessible.

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## **ADA Transition Plan:**

Last Updated October 10, 2016

1. Continue process of upgrading sidewalk ramps in Country Meadows Estates and Doubletree West to fully ADA compliance, work slated to start spring of 2017.
2. Move forward on planning an implementation of the Downtown Master Plan with the installation of ADA compliant sidewalks and crosswalks.
3. Work with the Township Trustee (owner of our town office and meeting area) to come to compliance with ADA requirements for the public restrooms of the government building.
4. Continue to ensure all programs are ADA compliant.
